TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Information on how to enter and the prizes forms part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2) The Promotional Period commences at Thursday 22 August 2019 9.00am (AEST) and closes on Thursday 20 August 2019 at 6.00pm (AEST)
- 3) Entry is open to NSW residents only. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter(s) are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
- 4) Any Eligible Entrants under 18 years old must have parental/guardian approval to enter and further, the parent/guardian of the entrant must read and consent to these Terms and Conditions. Parents/guardians may be required by the Promoter(s) to enter into a further agreement as evidence of consent to the minor entering this promotion.

 - c) Sunday, 20 October
 - i) 11:05am, 12:05pm, 1:05pm, 2:05pm, 3:05pm, 4:05pm
- 10) Prize must be collected within the following hour at the Information Desk.
- 11) In order to collect the prize, the winner must show proof of identification via a photo ID with name corresponding to name on registered ticket.
- 12) The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries, registrations and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry or registration that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry/registration process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
- 13) Subject to the unclaimed prize draw clause, if for any reason a winner does not take a prize by the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize will be forfeited.

- 14) If any prize is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the prize with a prize to the equal value and/or specification, subject to the relevant authorities.
- 15) Unclaimed Prize Draw. The winner is given 1 hour to claim their prize by coming to the Information Desk at the Home Show. Should it be necessary a redraw will take place for each hour that a prize is not claimed, during the following hour. The winner will be notified in the same manner as above, at the Information Desk and over the PA system at the event. The Promoter's decision is final in relation to all aspects of this promotion and no correspondence will be entered into.

- 21) Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under similar consumer protection laws in the State and Territories of Australia (Non-Excludable Guarantees). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability for any personal injury or any loss or damage whether direct, indirect, special or consequential arising in any way out of the promotion or use of a Prize.
